



Once you arrive at Shibuya Station, head to the 3rd floor `Urban Core` by using the pedestrian decks that connects directly to Shibuya Scramble Square. While its popularity is set to skyrocket in November 2019, don't miss exploring the northern area of Oku-Shibuya (includes Kamiyamacho, Udagawacho and Tomigaya) where unique shops can be found. Each shop has its own uniqueness and still, as youth as Shibuya's culture. Drop by and grab some snacks and drinks, then head to Yoyogi Park if you feel like taking a break before exploring your next destinations.

When you've finished with the youth culture, it's time for Yoyogi Hachimangu Shrine. This shrine is dedicated to Hachiman, the god of protection from evil and good luck. Their most popular festival is the Goldfish Festival, which is held in May and September.

Tokyo is about the harmony between traditional and modern culture, and here you can feel both of them.







Discover More of Shibuya!

The word "Shibuya" does not only refer to the Shibuya station area, but also the whole Shibuya-ku and neighboring areas. Everyone knows the popular landmarks around Shibuya Station, such as the Hachiko statue, Shibuya Hikarie and SHIBUYA109 shopping mall, but there is so much more to explore – roadside shops and distinctive shopping streets in various areas of the city, historical and cultural facilities, parks etc. Discover all of Shibuya by taking a long walk following this map.



SHIBUYA SCRAMBLE SQUARE



As the tallest building (230m) in Shibuya ward, the observation deck on Shibuya Scramble Square's 47th floor, named 'Shibuya Sky,' offers panoramic 360° views with the first phase East wing. Mt. Fuji to the west, Tokyo Sky SHIBUYASKY<GEO.COMPASS> Tree, Roppongi, and Tokyo Tower

to the east, and Shinjuku and Yoyogi Park to the north. To get a feel for what's hot in Shibuya, explore shops and restaurants around (B2-14th).
